The East Bay Chess Club Chess League is about to start! We are looking for teams of 4-10 players for some chess competition and fun. Players can put together a team, or join themselves and be placed on a team. The league will continue for 8 months, with each team playing one match per month. Matches will consist of four players per team, but teams may have up to ten players on the roster. Players will be assigned board numbers by rating. Board 1 players can be of any rating, board 2 players must be under 2200 USCF, board 3 players must be under 1900, and board 4 players must be under 1600.

entry to the league is \$200. Free entry to next year's league will be awarded to the top scoring team, and the top scoring player on each board will receive a digital clock with their name engraved. The reigning Champion is the UC Berkeley team, who finished last season with a score of 16/20. This is a great opportunity to play competitive chess, but it also gives a chance to lower rated players. Don't miss out. First Match is scheduled for November 20.
