His peak international ranking was 50th in the world in 1999 and he was the highest ranked Australian player from 1984 until his retirement in 2007. He's been an active Senior FIDE Trainer and has conducted group junior coaching with IM Daniel Naroditsky and GM Sam Shankland. He is a very good lecturer.
